

Blydskap Red Blend NV



Tempel Wines, (Est. 1784) is a boutique winery on the banks of the berg river in Paarl, South Africa.

All their wines are natural fermented and the vineyards are farmed as biological as possible.

- **Tasting notes:**

A blend of the younger vines at Tempel Wines. Grenache – Mourvèdre – Shiraz – and Carignan. Medium bodied, easy drinking Rhône style blend with a lot of red and darker fruit, well balanced acidity. Softer tannins.

- **Soil:**

Loamy soil and shale with a lots of river boulders

- **Vinification:**

Natural fermented in open concrete tanks. Manual punch downs during fermentation at 20-25 C. Matured in 300L older French oak barrels and concrete egg for 12 months.

- **Origin:**

Wellington and Paarl (Western Cape)
