

CHÂTEAU DU TERTRE 2023 MARGAUX

After adjustments in the 2022 vintage, Château du Tertre 2023 has undergone a significant transformation, not only increasing the Cabernet Sauvignon to 70% but also completely losing its reductive character. This wine maintains a juicy and crisp palate while introducing more spice; black pepper and licorice meander across the tongue, with a subtle trace of graphite powder pausing in the finish, cleverly enhancing the wine's complexity and concentration. **The 2023 vintage marks the awakening of Château du Tertre, heralding the onset of a new era for this estate.** Even so, a smoother tannin feel at the close would make it even more impressive.

2023 du Tertre is a bit toned down on the nose offering only hints of blackberries. The taste is packed and tight, with lots of unresolved tannins making this a tough encounter at the moment. Will there be fruit enough to carry this through to a harmonious development? Time will tell.

Lovely fruit, with blackberry, dark chocolate, walnut and meat aromas and flavors. Medium-bodied with a solid core of fruit, creamy tannins and just a hint of chocolate. 70% cabernet sauvignon, 15% merlot, 11% cabernet franc and 4% petit verdot. Needs three or four years of bottle age. Drink after 2028.

REVIEW

Ripe cassis and darker fruits intermixed with spicy wood, graphite, liquid violets, and sappy flowers emerge from the 2023 Château Du Tertre, a deep plum/purple-hued effort that shows impressive complexity. Medium-bodied on the palate, it has solid mid-palate depth, ripe, polished tannins, nicely integrated acidity, and a great finish. Based on 70% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Merlot, 11% Cabernet Franc, and 4% Petit Verdot and aged 14 to 16 months in 60% new French oak, this youthful Margaux deserves 4-5 years in the cellar and should have a solid two decades or more of overall longevity. Drink 2030-2046.

2023 Château du Tertre (Margaux)

Flowers, cocoa, raspberries, and spearmint nuances show in the perfume. Medium-bodied, soft, fruity, and fresh, this charm not shy about already starting to let you enjoy its black, and red fruit-filled, creamy-textured mid-palate, and finish. Drink from 2027-2045. **93** Tasted Mar17, 2026

The 2023 Château du Tertre has a more Merlot-driven bouquet, more red fruit here with violet and peony scents manifesting with time in the glass. The palate is medium-bodied with succulent tannins, fleshy and ripe, a keen line of acidity with a lightly peppered, quite elegant finish. This performs above my expectations from the barrel.
