THE REGION

Formed by gentle hills, with a slightly steep relief, the Lisbon IG extends from the capital of Portugal to the north, as far as Pombal, always along the coast. A multifaceted region, it encompasses several denominations of origin, both ancient and modern, with distinct characteristics. The climate is temperate, with an Atlantic influence, with relatively mild summers, cooler and more humid in areas closer to the sea, hotter and drier in areas protected by the Montejunto mountain range.

WINEMAKING

Fermentation on skins with temperature control at 28°C.

TASTING NOTES

Aromatic profile wine that represents well the complexity of this blend. Round tannins harmonize with freshness and acidity.
