

## CHÂTEAU LA TOUR DE MONS 2023

Margaux

### REVIEWS

#### **90/100 - Vinum**

Expressive, still slightly marked by wood, with red fruits in the background; Light, elegant, lively, well-balanced tannins, a spicy finish. Will please quickly.

#### **90/100 - Decanter**

Fragrant and lively on the nose. A marked freshness, with bluish accents of graphite, in the aromatic. Juicy and elegant, a bright and slender wine, chalky and eye-catching, much more "right bank" in style with the Merlot on clay and limestone. Clean and clear, nice precision and clarity, with always notes of cranberry and freshly picked strawberry. I love the stony grip on the finish. Fresh and composed, slightly toasted on the finish, but with a nice energy and a good focus. 4% Cabernet Franc completes the blend.

#### **91/100 - Jeff Leve**

Notes of forest leaves, tobacco, mint and red fruits make up the bouquet. With a medium body, supple, soft, round and juicy, give it another year or two to age: it will gain in fullness and soften very nicely. The blend combines 57% Merlot, 34% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Petit Verdot and 4% Cabernet Franc. Drink between 2027 and 2040.

#### **90/100 - Jane Anson**

Beautiful precision with sappy tannins and a feeling of energy, underlined by notes of cloves, with just a touch of austerity and slender raspberry and blueberry fruits. Located in the northern part of Margaux, with more clay and limestone in the subsoil than its sister estate Marquis d'Alesme. Harvest from 13 September to 7 October, yield of 32 hl/ha, 20% new oak barrels for ageing.
