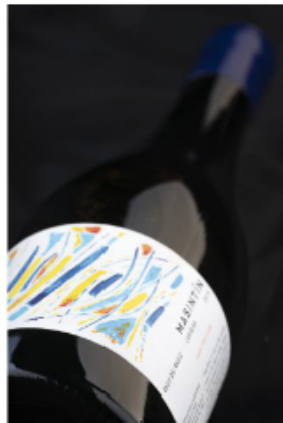

### Masintín Cariñena 2019 Valle del Maule

Truquilemu is one of the coolest areas in the Maule Valley, hidden by surrounding hills. It's cultivated by only a few small viticultores and one of them is Waldo Orellana, who still dry farms his 70+ year old bush vines by hand and horse. This Cariñena was fermented with native yeasts and aged in concrete tanks, cocchiopesto amphoras and old French oak barrels.

#### Origin

Truquilemu, Valle del Maule. This Cariñena is coming from a parcel surrounded by the granitic slopes of the coastal cordillera. It was planted back in 1950 and it is located 40 km from the Pacific Ocean. Gobelet pruning, non-irrigated and ungrafted.

#### Viticulturist

Waldo Orellana

#### Harvest

Hand-harvested on 25<sup>th</sup> of April 2019

#### Winemaking

Grapes were de-stemmed, fermented with native yeasts in cocchiopesto tanks during 15 days at 24° - 26°C with a mix of pigeages and pump overs. Total maceration lasted for 26 days. After maceration the wine was transferred to 28% used barrels and 72% cocchiopesto amphorae during 9 months prior bottling

#### Blend

93% Cariñena  
7% Cinsault

#### Analysis

pH: 3,27  
Residual sugar: 1,5 g/L
