Masintín Cariñena 2019 Valle del Maule

Truquilemu is one of the coolest areas in the Maule Valley, hidden by surrounding hills. It's cultivated by only a few small viticultores and one of them is Waldo Orellana, who still dry farms his 70+ year old bush vines by hand and horse. This Cariñena was fermented with native yeasts and aged in concrete tanks, cocciopesto amphoras and old French oak barrels.

Truquilemu, Valle del Maule. This Cariñena is coming from a parcel surrounded by the granitic slopes of the coastal cordillera. It was planted back in 1950 and it is located 40 km from the Pacific Ocean. Gobelet pruning, non-irrigated and ungrafted.

Hand-harvested on 25th of April 2019

Grapes were de-stemmed, fermented with native yeasts in cocciopesto tanks during 15 days at 24° - 26°C with a mix of pigeages and pump overs. Total maceration lasted for 26 days. After maceration the wine was transferred to 28% used barrels and 72% cocciopesto amphorae during 9 months prior bottling
