Masintín Cinsault 2020 Valle del Itata

70% of this Cinsault comes from a vineyard planted in 2002 in Los Castaños, 23 km away from the Pacific ocean, in a granitic slope of the coastal cordillera exposed to the northwest. The remaining 30% comes from a south facing granitic slope in Bularco planted back in 1960 that rests over a granitic soil too. Both parcels are gobelet pruned, non irrigated and ungrafted

Grapes were harvested by hand and fermented with native yeasts only. The wine was aged in concrete tanks, cocchiopesto amphoras and old French oak barrels.

Los Castaños, Valle del Itata. This Cinsault is coming from a parcel planted in 2002 located 23 km from the Pacific Ocean on granitic slopes of the coastal cordillera. The parcel has a north-east exposure. Gobelet pruning, non-irrigated and ungrafted

Hand-harvested on 15th of March 2020

Winemaking

Grapes were de-stemmed. We fermented with native yeasts in concrete and cocchiopesto tanks during 15 days at 24° - 26°C with a mix of pigeages and pump overs. Total maceration lasted for 23 days. After maceration the wine was transferred to 38% used barrels and 62% cocchiopesto amphorae during 10 months prior bottling
