

Skemerdans Grenache 2021



Tempel Wines, (Est. 1784) is a boutique winery on the banks of the bergriver in Paarl, South Africa.

All their wines are natural fermented and the vineyards are farmed as biological as possible.

- **Tasting notes:**

It exhibits savory dark cherries and hints of graphite. It is spicy and iron-driven with mineral tension, complemented by soft herbs and black raspberry notes in lighter-style.

- **Soil:**

Shale + Loam with river boulders

- **Vinification:**

Natural fermented in open concrete tanks. Manual punch downs during cold fermentation at 20-25 C. Matured in 300L French oak barrels and concrete egg for 12 months.

- **Origin:**

Piekenierskloof and Paarl
